FERPA

[PAST CASES](#)

Gives parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records.

VIOLATION EXAMPLE : A TEACHER GIVES STUDENT RECORD INFORMATION, SUCH AS GRADES, TO SOMEONE OTHER THAN THE LEGAL GUARDIAN.

VIOLATION EXAMPLE: WHEN THE INTERNET IS NOT CENSORED FOR THE STUDENTS AND THE STUDENTS ARE ABLE TO ACCESS ANY WEB PAGE THAT COULD CONTAIN SENSITIVE INFORMATION THEN THAT IS A VIOLATION.

COPPA

Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)

VIOLATION EXAMPLE: A TEACHER PROVIDES A STUDENT'S PERSONAL INFORMATION FOR ACCESS TO A WEBSITE WITHOUT THE PARENTS' CONSENT. (A CHILD IN THIS CASE INCLUDES ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 13.)

VIOLATION EXAMPLE
IF THE MUSIC TEACHER JUST COPIES A PEECE OF MUSIC WITHOUT AN EMERGENCY DUE TO A PURCHASED COPY THAT IS BEING USED FOR A PERFORMANCE THEN THAT IS A VIOLATION.

FAIR USE OF COPYRIGHT
